HOME SCHOOLING – CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The Holbrook Public School District shall declare home educated, who wish to participate, immediately eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics or other co-curricular activities if the following conditions are met:

1. Holbrook Public Schools policies on evaluating, monitoring, and continuing of home schooling apply (IHBGA, IHBGB).
2. The student's parents or legal guardians must submit a letter requesting participation in the school district's athletic program or other activities prior to the start of the school year with the understanding that the home educated student subscribes to the same rules and guidelines as all students. This notification is necessary in order to provide communication to the home-schooled student on what activities are available.
3. The Educational Plan for the home educated student has been approved by the public school Superintendent or his/her designee.
4. The Central Administration, in collaboration with the Principal(s), has determined appropriate high school grade level placement (7-12) for each home educated student in conjunction with chronological age and educational plan.
5. The student resides in the school district that serves the Junior-Senior High School and must be living with his/her parents or legal guardians in the family residence.
6. The Principal is satisfied that the student meets the guidelines for athletic or other activity participation required for all other students. This should include, but not be limited to, those rules governing transfers, academic eligibility, age requirements, and the number of consecutive seasons of athletic eligibility beyond grade eight.
7. Requirements relative to academic eligibility must be reviewed by the principal at the same times that all other student athletes are to be certified as academically eligible. Parents/guardians must submit a copy of the written assessment of their child's academic progress (as described in policy IHBGA) during the same times as grades are determined for the school's student population.
8. If the Principal determines that all eligibility standards detailed above have been met, the principal may declare the student immediately eligible to participate in interscholastic competition or in other co-curricular activities as appropriate.
