Automated External Defibrillators (AED)

The Holbrook School Committee approves the use of Automated External Defibrillators (AED) in district schools. AED's shall be used only by qualified persons as required by law.

The School Committee recommends that in addition to building staff, coaches, co-curricular and after-school advisors, and representatives from community groups regularly using school facilities also be trained and have demonstrated proficiency in the use of the AED.

To be qualified, a district employee shall have completed all training, and have demonstrated proficiency in the use of the AED as required by current law. The district and qualified person/s designated by the administration shall be immune from civil liability for operation of an automated external defibrillator.

The AED shall be located in a central location in each school building and be easily accessible. Each building principal shall designate a staff person who shall be responsible for the maintenance of the AED on a monthly schedule. A maintenance log shall be kept in the office.
